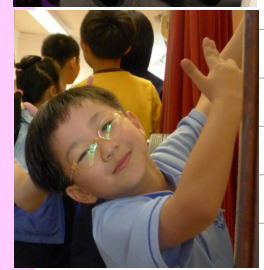

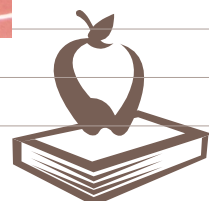

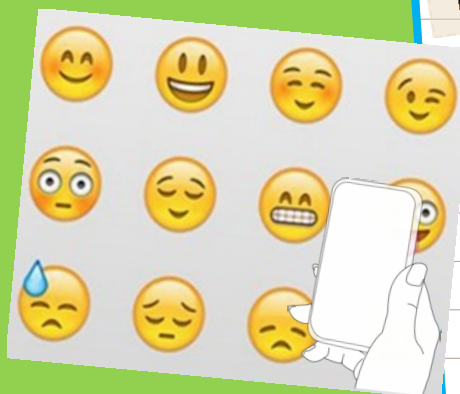
Now, the most popular emoticon, I think, is the happy face. They are recently more popular because they are small, cute, and easy to use.
